






# Informal employment depending on employment status (%)



#### 6 Share of informal employment by education level (%)





## Distribution of informal employment by level of education (%)












Distribution of informal & formal employment by enterprise size (%)







14 The impact of COVID-19 pandemic on the informal economy

Proportion of informal economy workers significantly impacted



High risk sectors: Wholesale and retail trade, repair of motor vehicles, motorcycles; Manufacturing; Accommodation and food services; Real estate; business and administrative activities.

Medium-high risk sectors: Arts, entertainment and recreation, domestic workers, and other services; Transport, storage and communication.

Medium-Risk sectors: Construction; Financial and insurance services; Mining and quarrying.

**Low-Medium risk sector:** Agriculture, forestry and fishing.

Low-risk sectors: Human health and social work activities; Education; Utilities; Public administration.
